


Urban Avenue: Street Closing & Development Agreement City Council Work Session | August 8, 2019

Presentation Purpose

- **Provide background and overview** of an upcoming street closing case
 - Proposed by developer to accommodate redevelopment of "Brame Building"
 - Not a typical street closing case
 - Multiple components: plat, easements, development agreement
 - Proximity to future Durham Belt Line Trail
- Share staff analysis of the developer's proposal
 - Based on deal point component valuations
- **Provide opportunity for Council to comment** on deal points before any developer's proposal is finalized for public hearing

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Redevelopment Project

- Akridge North Carolina is seeking to redevelop the Brame Building
- 36,628 SF of Class B creative office space
- Supports 100 full-time workers
- Street closing needed for parking (UDO / lenders) and site flexibility

Developer Proposal: Overview

• Close 934' of Urban Avenue


- Land split between Akridge, City, and William Browning
- 50/50 split under state law: City and Browning gaining their share; Akridge gaining their share + Duke Energy's share
- Some of Akridge's share of closed street to be used for parking
- Donate construction of 100' of Belt Line Trail
- Donate construction of 15 public parking spots
- Cash proffer of \$30,860
- Obtain a 10,161 SF Temporary Construction Easement from the City to accommodate construction
- Obtain a 2,142 SF Permanent Access Easment from City to accommodate access for Duke and Akridge
