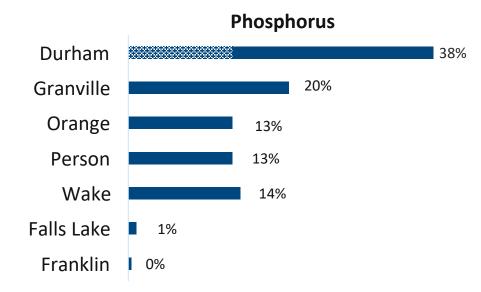




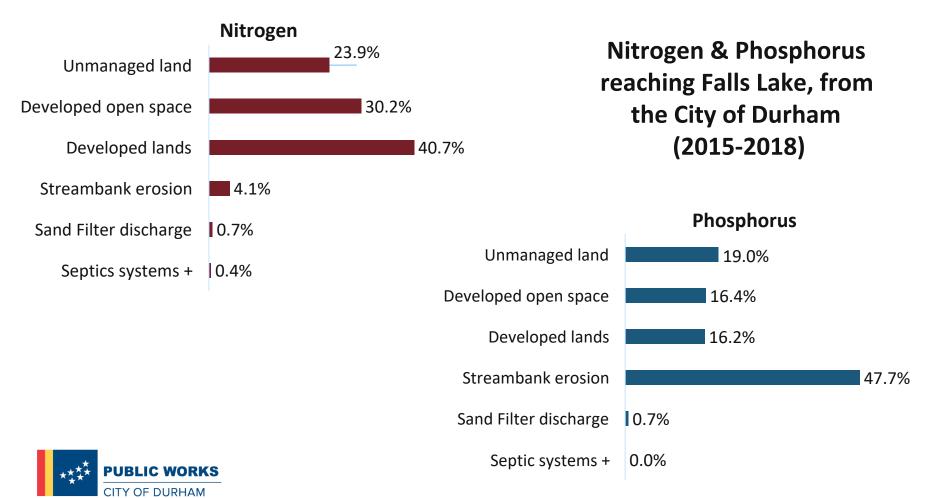












Preliminary Concepts and Principles

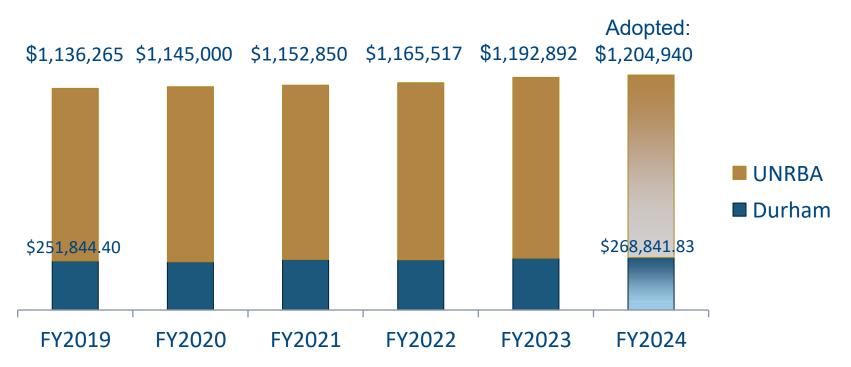
