













Also the really, really, big picture...

A primary driver of housing development, after market interest, is the cost of acquisition.

Neighborhoods within the urban tier with the lowest costs of acquisition will face the greatest risk of flipping for profit.





And the prevalence of courtprocessed evictions from 2012-2018 in these areas further illustrates how unstable housing already is for people living here.
