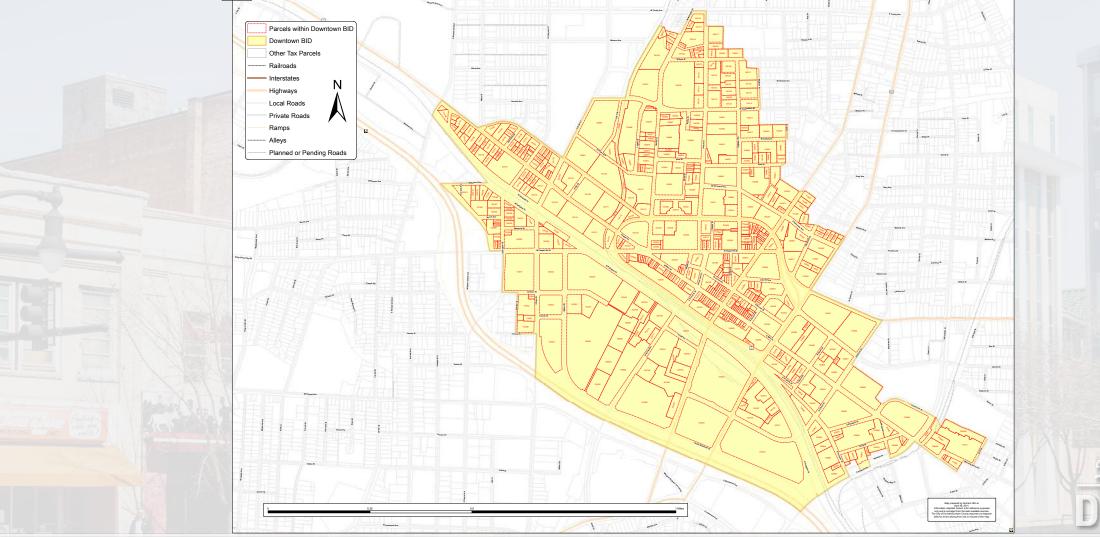


History
