BACKGROUND



BIPARTISAN INFRASTRUCTURE LAW (BIL)

- Signed into law in 2021
- Funding through different federal agencies
- 80% formula (non-competitive) and 20% competitive funding
- Transportation (72%), Energy(23%),
 Broadband (4%), Water (2%)
- Most funding is over 5 years (not one time funding)



INFLATION REDUCTION ACT (IRA)

- Signed into law in 2022
- Guidance released in 2023
- Mix of grants, loans, and tax incentives
- To encourage private investment in energy reduction.
- Create good-paying jobs, reducing energy and health care costs for families

Fiscal Recovery & Grant Assistance Service Agreement






